# SCHEDULE OF CONDITIONS IN ERANT METAL DEALERS

### **General Conditions**

### 1. The lic

person of his badge of office or written evidence hearing appointment to that office and shall allow such person to note the particularstoe Licence.

- 2. The Licence **bl**der shall at all times comply with the terms and requirements of all legislation applying to his/her business and in particular the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 and the Weights and Measures Act 1985 and any amending legislation.
- 3. The Licence Holder shall comply in all respects and at all times with the requirements of Sections 33Æ of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 and the requirements of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 (Metal Dealers and Itinerant Metal Dealers)

- (a) the weight and description of the metal
- (b) the name and address of the seller
- (c) the price paid for the metal
- 8. The Licence **b** der shall ensure that all records and receipts shall be kept for a period **b** months from the date of the sale.
- 9. The Licence **b**lder shall ensure that all receipts and records **thus** produced on request to an authorised officer of the Council or to a Constable for inspection.

### Change of Circumstances

- 10. Where there is a material change in circumstances **tiffg** the information which the Licence Holder supplied to the Council on the pipelication form for a licence, the Licence Holder shall notify the Licensing Authority such change as soon as reasonably practicable after it has taken places required by paragraph 9(1) of Schedule 1the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982. In particular change of the Licence Holds permanent address must be intimated within 7working days of the change.
- 11. All notifications to the Licensing Authority/hould be addressed todead of Legal and Regulatory SupportArgyll and Bute CounctKilmory,Lochgilphead, PA31 8RATiny Licence Holder in doubt as to what constitutes a change in circumstances should contact the office of the Headof Legal and Regulatory Supptort guidance.
- 12. When the holder of an itinerant metal dealer's licence has given up the activity of an itinerant metal dealer, he/she shall deliver the dence to the Licensing Audirity as required by paragraph 13(2) to Schedule 1 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982.
